What Is A Natter?

What is a GoF?

GoF stands for "Gathering of the Faithful". The TMGR hosts at least two multi-day GoF's annually, Fall and Spring. The Spring GoF is always held the second weekend in May in Salado, Texas, and the Fall GoF is located anywhere the hosts choose.

Past GoF locations include Fredericksburg, Waco, Austin and Montgomery. A GoF normally includes a car display, judging, a rallye or drive, and an awards presentation.

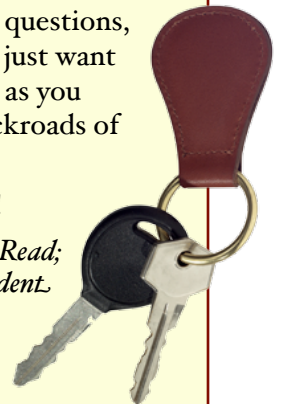
The MG is known throughout the world as the Marque of Friendship. Texas MG Register members embrace that friendly Texas spirit and welcome you to this wonderful club.
